SPECIAL AND SIGNIFICANT AWARDS : CRITERIA AND REGULATIONS

As at 20th March 2024

All Special and Significant Achievement Awards are presented at the Annual Awards Ceremony held the day before the commencement of the CTSASA Chairman's Cup.

1. Special Achievement Award (framed certificate)

1.1 Where a member has achieved any of the following in a recognised international championship:

1. High Gun 1st Overall
2. High Gun 2nd Overall
3. High Gun 3rd Overall
4. High Gun 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an individual category, i.e. Junior, Lady, Veteran, Super-Veteran, FITASC Senior category, FITASC Master category
5. As a member of an approved Protea Team – Team Bronze, Silver or Gold position.

1.2 List of Recognised International Championships for the purposes of the Special Achievement Award:

1. ISSF World Cup or equivalent event where Olympic Quota Places are available
2. ISSF World Championship
3. Commonwealth Games
4. Olympic Games
5. ASSF African Shooting Championships
6. ICTSF World Championships (DTL, English Sporting)
7. CPSA and NSCA World English Sporting Championships
8. FITASC World and European Championships (Sporting and Universal Trench)
9. ATA Trapshooting World Championship in ATA Trap, ATA Trap Doubles or Handicap. This refers to the specific individual event that is designated a World Championship.
10. NSSA Skeet World Championship (main and Junior World)

2. Certificate for Significant Achievement in an International Championship

A second tier of certification award for a “Significant Achievement in an International Championship” (unframed certificate) may be awarded for the following:

1. **A perfect score** in any of the **Recognised International Championships** as per 8.2 above, e.g. 200 ex 200 in ATA Trap or 150 ex 150 in NSSA Skeet.
2. **High Gun 4th, 5th or 6th Overall** in any of the **Recognised International Championships** as per 8.2 above.

3. Application for Award for Achievement in International Event

Where an international event is not specified in the above list of Recognised International Championships (1.2.1 to 1.2.10), any member in good standing may apply for a Special or Significant Achievement award via their CTSASA Provincial CTSA Delegate.

The member must supply the following information, in writing, to his/her CTSASA Provincial Delegate before 30th September in the year of the international event:

- a) *Full title of the international event*
- b) *Date of the international event*
- c) *Name of venue and country where the international event was held*
- d) *Confirmed and authenticated set of the official results of the international event*
- e) *Proof of entry and participation in the international event*
- f) *Details of the achievement, i.e. score and result achieved plus any awards/medals*
- g) *Motivation for the award, i.e. why the achievement should be recognised by the CTSASA as either a Special or Significant achievement.*

The application for the award will be assessed by the full Executive Committee of the CTSASA and the decision communicated to the applicant in writing.
